





know that. And so I wanted to slay a dragon to save a princess and become a freaking prince. And I knew that I didn't take this. I would regret it for the rest of my life.




Full Circle: Reflecting on Gratitude and Community.


Richard emphasizes the significance of building genuine connections, not only within his call center but extending into the broader community through educational scholarships and local engagement. He highlights


Passion: The Key to Unlocking Success


Giving Back: Scholarship Initiative at Alma Mater.
