

In this tutorial i will show you how to export highlighted text in a pdf to a summary file. export comments to a data file. fdf) or acrobat xfdf files (\*. the easiest way is to copy the highlighted text into the comments and then generate a comments summary. but the new and updated version of pdf studio comes with the ability to export highlighted text from a pdf document directly.

to copy text, use the selection tool in acrobat reader or use the right- click menu in chrome to copy text from the pdf. this will allow you to extract and view only the highlighted text. in the previous versions of pdf studio and older, users first need to turn on the "copy text to note" feature and then highlight the document. for the latter you can use the built- in command, or use a script, but the former requires using a script. to fetch highlighted text from pdf, open pdf file on its interface, and access the comment tab. afterward, they can export the highlighted texts.

specify a location for the file, and then click save. in that tab, click on export option available in manage comments section. name the file and choose acrobat fdf files (\*. hope this answers your query. before copying, check if the pdf allows copying by going to file > properties in acrobat reader and checking the "content copying" value. you will see the. from the options copy highlighted text in pdf menu in the comments list, choose export all to data file. xfdf) for the file type.
