To do so, simply use the Open command in the menu and select your image file. This appearance makes any text look low-quality and will likely be exported in even worse shape. A common reason for pixelated text in Photoshop is an incorrect Anti-Aliasing setting. Type new text to replace the selected text, or press Delete to remove it.; To rotate the text box, use the rotation handle at the top of the selected text box. You can create lists and, conversely, convert a list item to a paragraph or change list types.
