Black has three main options, Bb4 (the Winawer Variation), Nf6 (the Classical Variation), and dxe4 (the Rubinstein Variation). The French Defense starts after e4 e5. Black's move by prepares the d7-d5 push to challenge White's center immediately. e6 also opens lines for Black's dark-squared bishop and queen, an advantage over the Caro-Kann and Slav Defense (where Black also plays for the d7-d5 push) covers the French Defense and some Sicilian sidelines.
