Upload your document. Step 1. Locate and open the PDF document on your system using the default app 'Preview'. Preview is available as a core macOS app, so you'll find it on any Mac computer. Method: Password Protect PDF on Mac Natively. Do not confuse with 'Export as PDF'.

Step 2. Click on the 'File' tab on the menu bar and look for the option 'Export'. Select the file or drag it onto the screen, create a password, and then click the 'Protect' button. This is a quite common issue and needs update. In order to remove a password from PDF file on Mac, the simplest way is using Preview app.

How to Set a password for opening, printing, or changing a PDF. In the Preview app on your Mac, open a PDF. Choose File > Export. Step 3. There are a variety of ways you can password-protect a PDF file: with the Mac's Preview app, with Microsoft Word or with Adobe. The file needs to be open for you to be able to set a password.
