You can send a copy of any file in the Files app to others. If you have a document you want to send that isn't digitized, you can scan it with Files first To transfer PDF files to your iPad using iCloud, follow these steps: Open your iCloud Drive, or go to and sign in with your Apple login. Choose Contacts Only or Everyone as per your need. If you can't find it, swipe down and search for it.
