

Keep in mind you can only search the text in a PDF document if it includes actual text Make a PDF searchable with Adobe Acrobat, or drop PDF here. Press CTRL+F (Windows) or CMD+F (Mac). OCR your PDF to get text from scanned documents. In the free PDF Reader, this shows as a search box with a magnifying glass. Then: Choose the aspect ratio for your PDF file. In the text box, enter your search term. In the Find text box, type your search term, then Enter the word or phrase you want to find in your document in the Find dialogue box. If you need text recognition choose Convert with OCR. Configure the OCR On Mac, control-click the PDF file. Simply upload your PDF and recognize text automatically. Open any PDF with your default PDF reader. This will also work if you open a PDF in Adobe Reader or Mac PreviewPress Ctrl + F (Windows) or # Cmd + F (Mac).
