PART II TERRITORIAL SEA AND CONTIGUOUS ZONE SECTION 1 Convention de Vienne sur le droit des traités (avec annexe) Vol., United Nations — Treaty Series Nations Unies — Recueil des Traités Adoptée par l'Assemblée générale des Nations Unies le décembre States Parties condemn racial discrimination and undertake to pursue by all appropriate means and without delay a policy of eliminating racial discrimination in all its forms and Article Use of terms For the purposes of the present Convention: "treaty" means an international agreement concluded between States in written form and governed by international law, whether embodied in a single instrument or in two or more related instruments and whatever its particular designation; Article The functions of a diplomatic mission consist, inter alia, in: Representing the sending State in the receiving State; Protecting in the receiving State the interests of the sending State and of its nationals, within the limits permitted by international law; Negotiating with the Government of the receiving State; (2) This Convention applies mutatis mutandis to the entities referred to in article, paragraph 1(b), (c), (d), (e) and (f), which become Parties to this Convention in accordance with the conditions relevant to each, and to that extent "States Parties" refers to those entities. This document contains the text of the Convention on International Civil Aviation, signed at Chicago on ember (hereinafter referred to as the "Convention"), in the Volumes 2, and contain the documents generated in English, French and Spanish by the Convention drafters.
