Then, follow these steps: Open the PDF in Acrobat Pro on Windows or Mac. Choose Tools > Encrypt > Remove Security. If the document has a Document Open password, click OK to remove it. If the document has a permissions password, type the correct password in the Enter Password box and then click OK.
