You can delete sensitive text, graphics, or Start by opening your chosen PDF in Adobe Acrobat Pro. Head to the Redact tool (found in the navigation menu). Open the document you wish to redact in Adobe Acrobat Pro DC in the normal way. Click the Tools button in the top-left of the screen and scroll down to the Protect & Standardize section. Select the Redact button in the Tools Center. Select the text or image you want to redact. Go into the Tools menu and select Redact.
