

I'm excited to share my story and expertise with your audience. Together, we can break the cycle of overworking and prioritize well-being. Who's ready to bring their full, authentic self to work?



I believe that with friendships, you can be vulnerable. If you have food on your face, your tie is not straight. And even in business, we have natural attrition here. People will leave me because of a scheduling conflict for the university. Maybe their boyfriend or girlfriend works at Amazon. It could be closer to their home and maybe other lucrative opportunities, but they never get the walk of shame or I yell at them. And when it comes to these sort of situations that you're talking about, I'll call my clients immediately. And I'll let them know what's happening.


Why Costa Rica is a Top Destination


