Local anaesthetic eye drops, eg Amethocaine %, Oxybuprocaine %. Fluorescein strips or Minims. A visual field test can determine if you have blind spots (called scotoma) in your vision and where they are. Using a penlight, Finhoff transilluminator, or the light provided by a direct ophthalmoscope, a general examination of the eyelids and the eye Eye care is a nonthreatening form of health care, particularly to patients who are reluctant to seek general or preventive medical care This Optometric Clinical Practice Guideline Visual field testing can detect blind spots.
