This process works for any file type on your Mac Here's how you can rename a PDF file on your Mac: StepLaunch Finder, select a PDF file, and press Return. It is beneficial for reducing the size of large files to conserve disk space, bandwidth, and computer memory, as well as for adjusting the paper size for printing. You can then proceed to amend the document metadata such as the Title, author, etc. In the pop-up menu below Rename Finder Items, choose to replace text in the names, add text to the names, or change the name format. Additionally, it can increase the dimensions of a PDF, but it'sRename Files On a Mac. First, locate your PDF either in the finder or on your desktop. Follow these steps to convert a file to PDF or export a PDF to another format using the Acrobat PDF converter: Click the Select a file button above, or drag and drop a file into the drop zone. Under Open Settings, select Always Use Filename As Document Title In Microsoft Word, Click on "File" in the menu barNavigate to "Info"> Click on "Properties"> Double click on "Advanced Properties". Watch Adobe Acrobat do its PDF conversion magic A new document preference is added to let you use the filename as the document title. Click the first PDF file you want to rename, or press "Ctrl-A" to select all the PDF files at onceRight-click on the PDF file you selected, or, if you selected all the PDF Open the PDF with Notepad++ and search (CTRL+F) for /Title Change title between brackets (and leave the brackets) For instance: Change "/Title (OLD TITLE)" into "/Title You do this just like you rename any other file, by using your operating systems's file name functions. It cannot be renamed using the DOS prompt but it has "too long name or extension". Here's how you can rename a PDF file on your Mac: StepLaunch Finder, select a PDF file, and press Return. By default, the preference is disabled. Select Rename and you'll be able to remove or add text to the name of the file by typing on your keyboard. Then, right-click it. On your Mac, select the items, then Control-click one of them. You do this just like you rename any other file, by using your operating systems's file name functions. Select the document you want to convert. If you leave the Title field blank, the file name will be reflected in the Open the file you want to convert. StepEnter a new PDF name and press Return again.
