Select Print, Watch as Acrobat online services convert your Excel sheet to PDF automatically, Do one of the following: To print a partial sheet, click the sheet, and then select the range of data that you want to print, Optionally, assign a nicelooking icon by clicking on the Change Icon button. Click "File" and then "Print" or Ctrl + P. Choose "Print to PDF" in the printer dropdown. Click the blue button labeled "Select a file" or drag and drop your Excel sheet into the drop zone. You can also press Ctrl+O. Download the converted file as a PDF. All of your formatting translates over perfectly in just a One advantage of getting the PDF Keyboard Shortcut Cheat Sheet is that you can (later) bring the keyboard shortcuts from the PDF file into Excel to rearrange them according to your preferences. Select File, and then click Print. Click on the Select all Sheets option Open your Excel file on your computer. Print a partial sheet, an entire sheet, or an entire workbook, Name the shortcut accordingly — e.g., Convert Excel Sheets to PDF. Now, open the folder that contains the Excel sheets that you want to convert to PDF. Select the files, right-click on the selection, and click Send to. Click Convert Excel Sheets to PDF in the SendTo set the same DPI printing options for all Excel sheets in a workbook and print that workbook in a single PDF, follow these steps: Open the Excel workbook and right-click on the tab for any of the sheets you have in your workspace (by default they sheet tabs are named Sheet1, Sheet2,). Note: If a worksheet has defined print areas, Excel will print only those print areas. If you don't want to print only the defined print area, select the Ignore print area check box Click FILE > Print. Under Settings, select the arrow next to Print Active Sheets and select the appropriate option. You can also press Ctrl+P. All workbook files that you want to print must be in the same folder.
