I've followed guides from HP (printer brand) as well as others, and I've created a custom form in the print server settings, but I can't get it to show as an option on the Hello. > In the left side menu, click on "Printers and scanners". To begin, launch File Explorer and find your photo file. This tutorial will show you different ways on how to add or remove the Microsoft Print to PDF printer for all users in Windows Contents. On Windows, you can print a document to PDF from any application, thanks to the built-in Print to PDF feature. How to Install/Add Microsoft Print to PDF Printer on Windows/[Tutorial]Windows allows you to Print to PDF natively using the Microsoft Print to PDF. You need administrator credentials to use Set-PrintConfiguration. The process of adding a custom paper size to Microsoft Print to PDF is relatively simple. > Click on "Devices". My printer only takes A4 paper, so I need to print this in booklet style (i.e. sheets of A5 printed on sides of A4 paper, but I am struggling with settings. Click on Start button in Windows and Devices and Printers. Right Click on the Printer to which you are trying to print and take Printer Properties (This is Printer Properties not Properties). Click on Preferences. Now, depending upon your printer, you will see the paper size in this screen itself or you will need to click on Advanced. To define a different paper size for Microsoft Print to PDF follow the steps: > Open Windows Settings. Here are the steps to follow: Open the "Printers & Scanners" settings in Windows.
