Establish Students who track their own behaviors gain greater control over those behaviors. The purpose of the checklist is to evaluate (or if a student fills it in themselves, to self-evaluate) their behavior This behavior checklist can be used before starting an activity to ensure that you are prepared (e.g., before beginning independent work) or after the activity (e.g., at the completion of independent work) to track whether you displayed target behaviors.
