Eligible veterans have the opportunity to add the word "VETERAN" to the front of their driver license or ID card to indicate that they have served in the military. Find out how to complete DMV business online as a veteran or active duty military member in California. County Veteran Service Office (CVSO) THIRD, Go online or call DMV for an appointment. Note: The California Driver License or California State Identification Card Veteran Designation does not qualify the card holder for any other benefits or compensation provided by the United States Department of Veteran Affairs or the California Department of Veteran Affairs (CalVet). Visit DMV. Go on-line or call any DMV for an appointment. The Veteran designation can only be added or removed at a field office. To schedule an appointment at any DMV, visit or call. Then you must visit a DMV office to obtain your DL/ID card with the Veteran designation. Then bring your Veteran Status Verification Form to DMV. Complete your application, pay any application fees in addition to a \$5 Veteran designation fee, and complete any testing requirements. To schedule an appointment at any DMV, visit or call. DO NOT go to the Veterans Affairs Regional Office (VA) or the California Department of Veterans Affairs (CalVet) as they DO NOT provide the verification form. California Vehicle Code section (c)(5) required you to apply for the Veteran designation in person at a DMV field office that processes DL/ID cards. Then bring your Veteran Status Verification Form to DMV. Complete your application. To apply for the veteran designation on your DL/ID card, you will need to: Obtain a Veteran Status Verification Form (VSD) which will be issued by the County Veteran Service Office. Go to your local CVSO to request a Veteran Status Verification Form (VSD) to complete the certification that you meet the definition of a disabled veteran under CVC Instructions for Veteran Designation on the Drivers License. The benefits of having the Veteran designation on your DL/ID card, proudly recognizes military service members. A new law for Veteran Designation on Driver's Licenses (SB) eliminates the \$5 fee for obtaining a military "VETERAN" designation on a driver's license or identification (ID) card. Then bring your Veteran Status Verification Form to DMV. Complete your application, pay any application fees in addition to a \$5 Veteran designation fee, and complete any testing requirements. Visit Any DMV. Go on-line or call any DMV for an appointment. If they have an uncharacterized or unknown discharge status, the CVSO will verify eligibility before approving the application.
