The Yale Senior Society System

The Yale senior society system is unique in the United States and indeed in the world. It is a fraternal system in which members are selected in their junior year and spend only ONE year on campus in the society.

This is totally unlike the usual campus fraternities where three or four years are spent as a member on campus. In brief, the Yale senior society system is NOT A CAMPUS FRATERNITY AT ALL. IT IS GEARED TO THE POST-GRADUATION OUTSIDE WORLD.

From the start of our exposure of The Order it was clear that Skull & Bones was only a segment of a conspiracy for political power.

This observation was clarified in the first volume INTRODUCTION TO THE ORDER (page 55). In an explanatory diagram we shaded only one quarter of a circle that represented the inner core, the power elite. That one quarter represented Skull & Bones. Other parts of the circle remained to be identified.

We can now positively identify another segment: KINGSLEY TRUST, also known as Scroll & Key. This is another Yale senior society, founded by members of Skull & Bones (RUSSELL TRUST) a few decades after the founding of Skull & Bones itself.

We have now received a batch of data which strongly suggests - even on preliminary analysis - that Scroll & Key is a vital element in the establishment power structure. (*) It has interlocks with Skull & Bones and other societies.

The Mysterious Power Of Yale

The official history of Yale University by George Wilson Pierson-YALE COLLEGE (Yale University Press, New Haven 1952 p. 5) has the following extraordinary statement:

"The power of the place remains unmistakable. Yale was organized. Yale inspired a loyalty in its sons that was conspicuous and impressive. Yale men in after life made such records that the suspicion was that even there they were working for each other. In short Yale was exasperatingly and mysteriously successful. To rival institutions and to academic reformers there was something irritating and disquieting about old Yale College".

It now appears that indeed some Yale men were quietly working together in life after Yale.

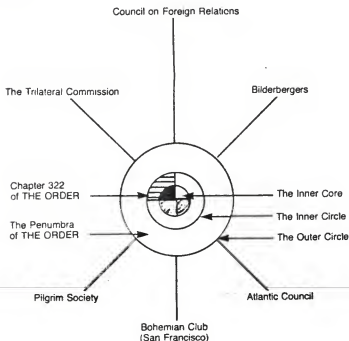
It also now appears that this "mysterious success" has a simple explanation: the three senior societies at Yale are meshed in a network of power and influence to promote their own members and deny outsiders.

These societies are: Skull & Bones (Russell Trust), Scroll & Key (Kingsley Trust) and Wolfs Head (Phelps Trust).

Further, these senior societies have representatives in yet other Yale societies. For example: The ELIHU society catalog has this entry:

"Anson Phelps Stokes (Skull & Bones. Honorary member of Elihu since the Founding in 1903.)"

So if we redraw the diagram on page 55 of INTRODUCTION TO THE ORDER it comes out as follows:





The above diagram differs from that printed previously on page 55 of INTRODUCTION TO THE ORDER as follows:

- *Three quarters of the "inner core" is now identified.
- *The additions are:
 - Scroll & Key - Kingsley Trust
 - Wolfs Head - Phelps Trust
- *This leaves only one quarter to be identified. However our original assumption may be wrong. It may well be that each of the senior societies comprises one third of the inner core.
- *It should be noted that all observers agree that Scroll & Key and Wolfs Head are subordinate, weak sisters compared to Skull & Bones.

The Auchincloss Family

The addition of Scroll & Key to the inner core solves some long standing research problems.

For example a key figure in modern history is "Colonel" Edward Mandel House, aide and confidante to President Woodrow Wilson and an extraordinary power behind the scenes in the period 1910 to 1920.

Yet House never went to Yale, and we have not yet been able to account for the undoubted power he wielded.

We previously identified House as a friend of Yale initiates in The Order. We also know that he went to school in New Haven and grew up with members of The Order. On page 47 of HOW THE ORDER CREATES WAR AND REVOLUTION we noted that Kenneth Durant, a Soviet agent and TASS correspondent in the United States was a one time aide to Edward House.

We can now make a closer link between House and The Order.

A member of Scroll & Key is GORDON AUCHINCLOSS (1908). We reprint below the official Scroll & Key biography of Auchincloss:

Note the following:

- *Auchincloss was a director of Chase National Bank
- *Auchincloss was secretary to "Colonel" House during the Peace Conference in 1919.
- *Auchincloss married Janet House, daughter of "Colonel" House.
- *The son of Auchincloss is named Edward House.
- *Auchincloss was a director of Solvay American Corp., an almost unknown corporation in the U.S. but a key to the early development of the Soviet chemical industry.

Other members of the Auchincloss family in Scroll & Key are:

- *Hugh Auchincloss, (1901) Surgeon.
- *Hugh Auchincloss, Jr., (1938) Surgeon, married Bundy family. See p. 73 of INTRODUCTION TO THE ORDER.
- *Hugh Auchincloss, III (1972) Surgeon.
- *Hugh Dudley Auchincloss, (1879) Left legacy to Kingsley Trust.
- *James Coates Auchincloss, (1908) Military Intelligence.
- *Joseph Howland Auchincloss, (1908) Attorney Davis, Polk, Wardell, Sunderland and Kiendl. (See this editor's WALL STREET AND THE BOLSHIEVIK REVOLUTION for the significance of this law firm.)

In brief, the Auchincloss family, prominent behind the scenes in U.S. history is closely linked to Scroll & Key.

The Acheson Family

A key figure in modern history, particularly in the development of relations with the Soviet Union was Secretary of State Dean Acheson, who was William Bundy's father-in-law. The Bundy family is, as we have noted extensively in previous volumes, intimately connected with Skull & Bones.

Dean Acheson was Scroll & Key and his biography reads as follows:

Acheson's son David Campion is Skull & Bones, while David Campion, Jr., is Scroll & Key, thus perpetuating the Acheson family in the inner core of the establishment.

We have formerly cited Vance for his partnership in the establishment law firm Simpson, Thacher and Bartlett whose notable contribution to history has been support of the Bolshevik Revolution in 1917-1919. (See this editor's book, WALL STREET AND THE BOLSHEVIK REVOLUTION)

As Secretary of State Vance continued this tradition of blindness when it comes to U.S. technical assistance to Soviet military power.

Vance today is a notable supporter of unilateral disarmament and an appeasement approach to the Soviets.



Conclusions

1. When we add Scroll & Key, an offshoot of Skull & Bones to the establishment inner core we find numerous powerful influences can be accounted for (we cited above Auchincloss, Acheson & Vance).
2. This new segment is notable as including officials responsible for the development and encouragement of the Soviet Union dating back to 1917.
3. It seems logical to also add Wolfs Head (Phelps Trust), the third of the Yale senior societies, to our picture of the inner core of the establishment.
4. When we equate the establishment with the three Yale senior societies it appears that very few key establishment figures are outside this charmed circle. To be true Harvard, Princeton and other Universities have made a contribution, but the core now appears to be "Yale Power".
