Correspondence René Descartes and Princess Elisabeth of Bohemia –9 is to be feared that the humours that were discharged in that way [presumably meaning: 'as you have described'] were stopped by the winter cold and that in spring they will bring back the same trouble or put you in danger of something else—if you Elisabeth, Princess Palatine of Bohemia (–) is most well-known for her extended correspondence with René Descartes, and indeed these letters constitute what we currently know of her extant philosophical writings

Between the years and, Princess Elisabeth of Bohemia (–80) and René Descartes (–) exchanged fifty-eight letters—thirty-two from Descartes and twenty-six from Elisabeth.
