V © RTTPDF-ShellTools is a software that extend the Windows Shell and provide access to several tools to work with PDF documents directly from the Shell environment. With it we can perform many common tasks with our PDF documents, and without the need to open Adobe Acrobat or any other PDF desktop application. The shell waits for synchronous commands to complete before accepting more input; asyn-chronous commands continue to execute in parallel with the shell while it reads and executes additional commands.
