The Theme refers to the central idea or underlying message of the text. Goethe considered motifs ever-recurring manifestations of the Theme is NOT: expressed in a single word. One key characteristic of literary themes is their universality, which is to say that themes are ideas that not only apply to the specific characters and events of a book or play, but also express broader truths about human experience that readers can shows that motif is defined as: (1) a subject, a central idea, thematic element used in the development of an artistic or (2) a distinctive figure in a design in architecture or oration; independent, significant phrase or melodic unit in musical.
