Use highlight mode: Click the Highlight button (so it turns grey), click the In the Preview app on your Mac, open the PDF you want to change. Click the highlighted area of text Open the PDF document in Highlights. Choose the third icon — the trash symbol — to remove the highlighted text in the bar on top select the arrow selecting tool next to the hand, and click on the highlight area then click delete depending on how many times you highlighted it, it removes layer every click Step Launch the platform across the device and tap on “My Computer” from the left panel to open the options to import file across it. From the menu bar choose File > Open. Use highlight mode: Click the Highlight button (so it turns gray), click the down arrow next to the In the Preview app on your Mac, open the PDF you want to change. You can also view the Highlights and Notes on the left sidebar and you can delete the highlights by selecting one and pressing the Delete key. Quickly highlight, underline, or strike through text: Select text, click the down arrow next to the Highlight button, then choose a highlight color, underline, or strikethrough. A small toolbox will appear with three icons. This will bring up the annotation popover Click the Pencil icon on the toolbar in Preview to toggle it off. This will create a blue outline around the text. Locate and select the file you want to open, then click Open. Tap on “Browse” to import the files across Adobe Acrobat successfully.
