Thank you for purchasing my G2A Method. With this method, you will be able to get anything from <https://www.g2a.com/> completely for free. This exploit works for any product available for sale on G2A, **for example:**

Giftcards - <https://www.g2a.com/category/gift-cards-c6>

Games - <https://www.g2a.com/category/games-c189>

How does it work?

It's simple. We will use a Tampermonkey script that changes the timezone of our browser whenever we make a new order on G2A. As soon as we are redirected to the payment page, our timezone will change, which will result in our order being marked as "Expired" on G2A's payment processor - Bitbay. However, the order **will not be marked as expired on G2A's side**. If we pay for the products, the order will be successfully processed and delivered by G2A, but the money will be instantly refunded to our wallet by Bitbay if it's a high value transaction (over 0.001 BTC).

Here is a summary of the process:

1. Install the Google Chrome extension Tampermonkey. Enable Developer mode in Google Chrome and restart your browser. Install a script that changes your browser's timezone after making an order on
2. G2A. Create a new order on G2A and pay for the products with Bitcoin. Claim your products (the order will be successfully processed by G2A). Wait a few minutes for a refund from Bitbay (Bitbay is a Bitcoin
3. payment processor for G2A. They will refund your money because the order is marked as "Expired" on
4. their side due to the timezone conflict).

Important: Please read this or it won't work. Keep in mind that Bitbay will only refund your expired order if it is above **0.001 BTC**. Any lower amount is not prioritized by their refund system and will require you to contact G2A's support to get a refund. This will result in your request being REJECTED, as they will find out that the order was already processed by them (you have received the products). If you use any amount higher than **0.001 BTC**, it will be automatically refunded without problems.

To make this work, you must add products to your cart that are worth at least 0.001 BTC in total. It could be one or multiple products - it doesn't matter. There are no limits on the maximum worth of your cart.

Okay, let's begin.

Here are the things you need:

- At least 0.001 BTC to pay for the order

- Google Chrome browser

- Tamper monkey extension

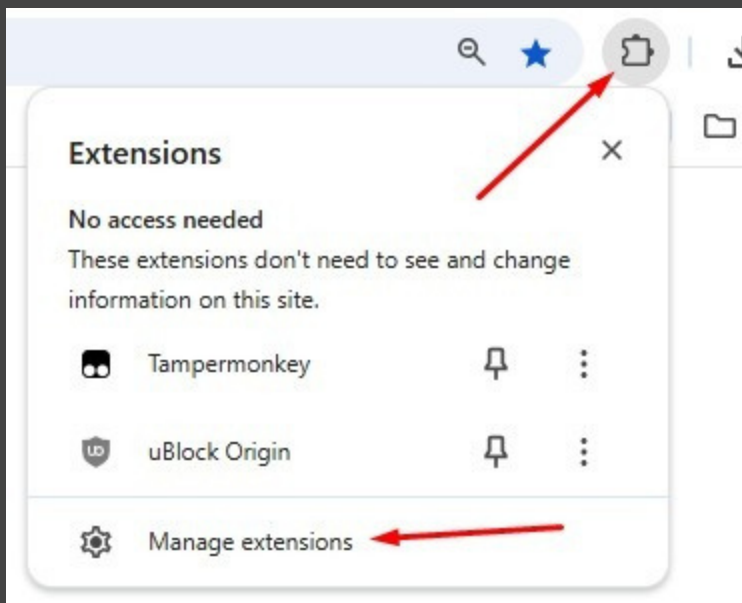
Important: If you get any errors while trying to make an order, check the last page of this eBook for possible solutions.

Edit: I have received multiple questions asking if this script will work with other payment methods. The answer is no. If you want to use this method, you must use Bitcoin. It's not hard to buy crypto nowadays, so it shouldn't be a problem.

If you have everything ready - follow these steps:

Step 1. Add the **Tampermonkey** extension to your browser.

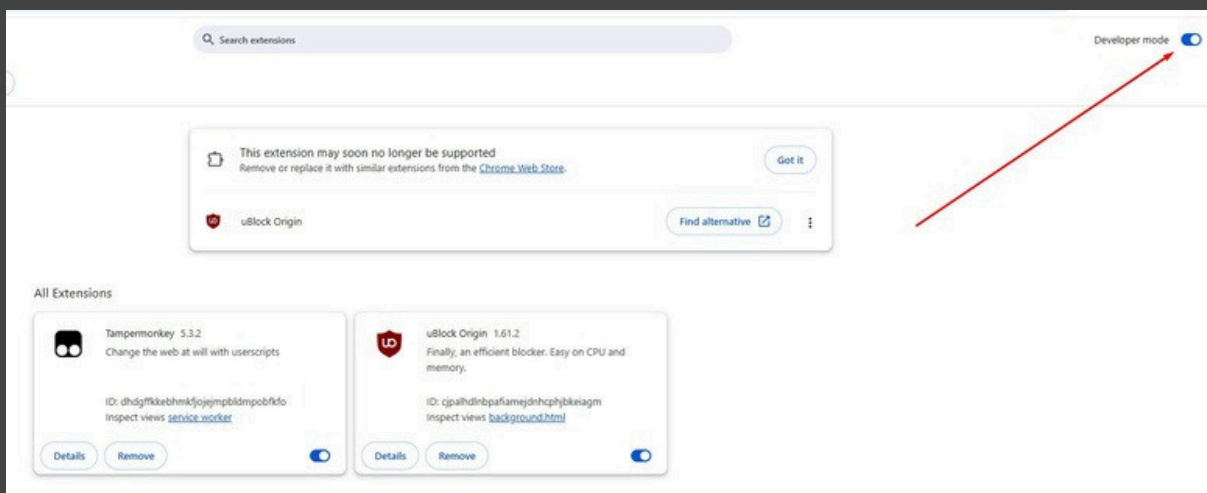
Step 2. Enable **Developer Mode** in Google Chrome. To do this, click the Extensions icon in the top-right corner of your browser, navigate to "Manage Extensions," and toggle on Developer Mode at the top-right corner.



Or simply copy and paste **chrome://extensions/** to the URL Bar and click Enter.

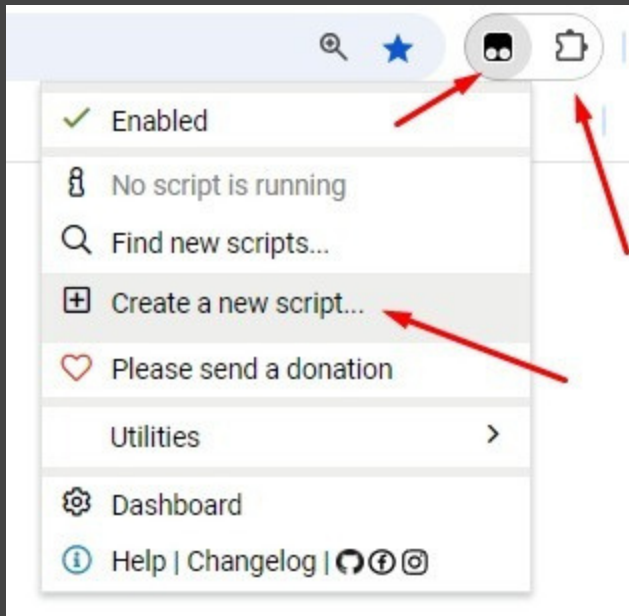


Then you have to enable developer mode here:

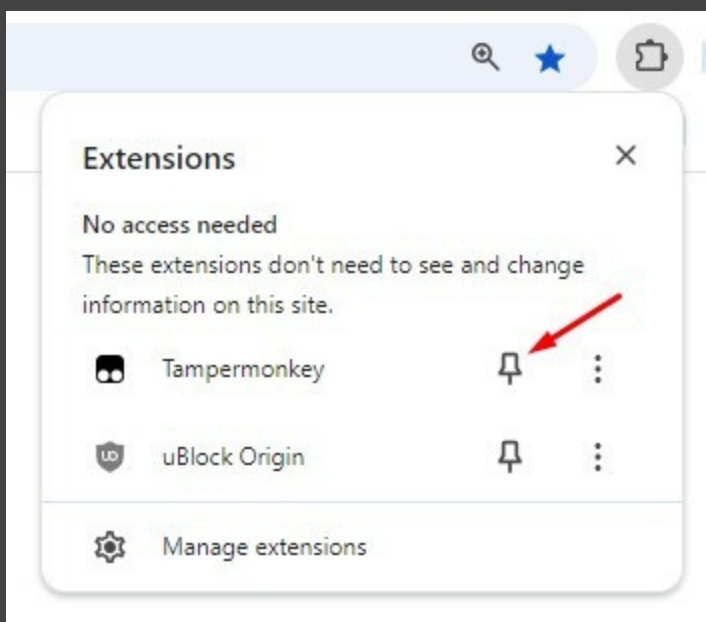


Step 3. Restart your Google Chrome browser after enabling Developer Mode (simply close it and open it again). It's important - if you don't do it, this method won't work!

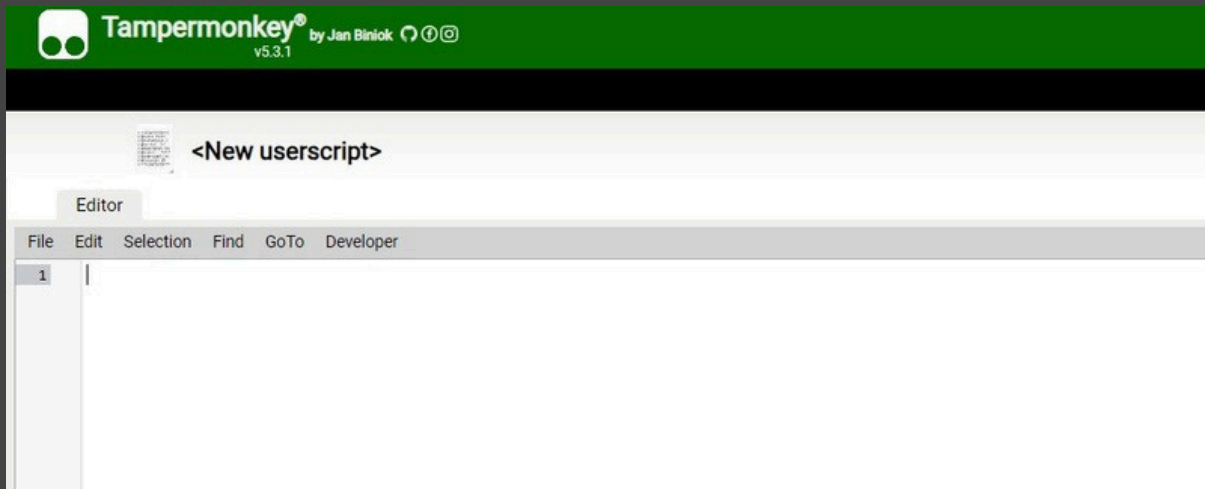
Step 4. Click on Tampermonkey's icon at the top-right side of your browser and click the plus icon - "Create a new script".



Important: If you can't find the Tampermonkey icon, click here in your Google Chrome browser and then pin the extension. When you do that, the extension will be visible in the top-right corner of your browser.



Step 5. Remove any preset code so you have a clean page like the screenshot below:

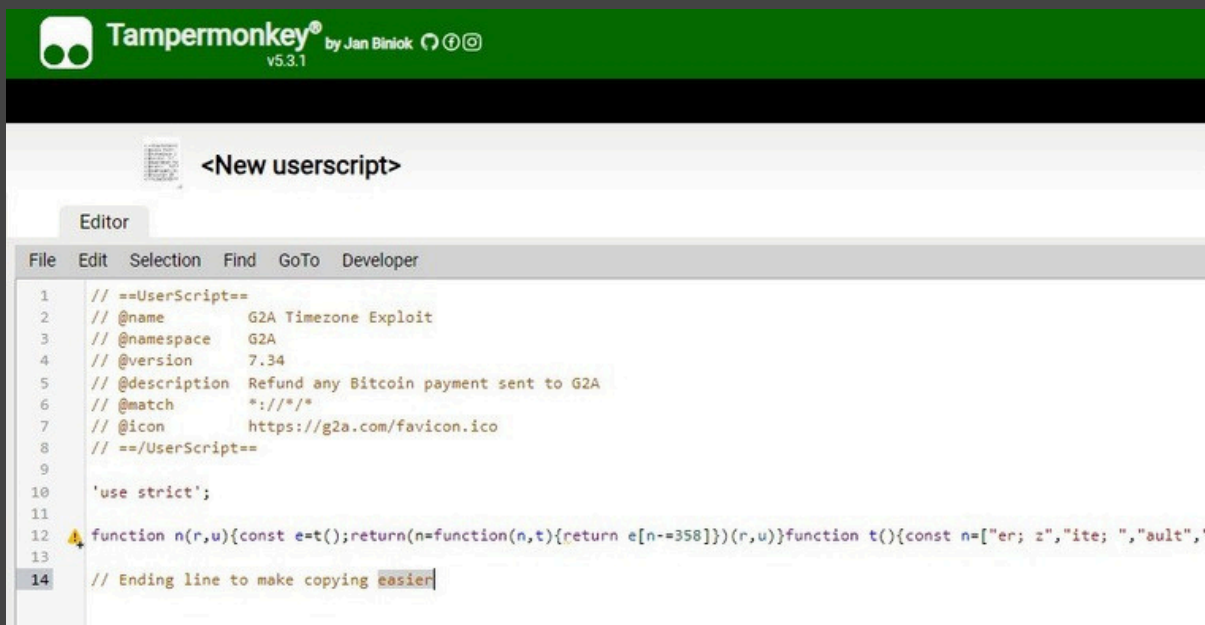


Step 6. Copy the script from one of these links:

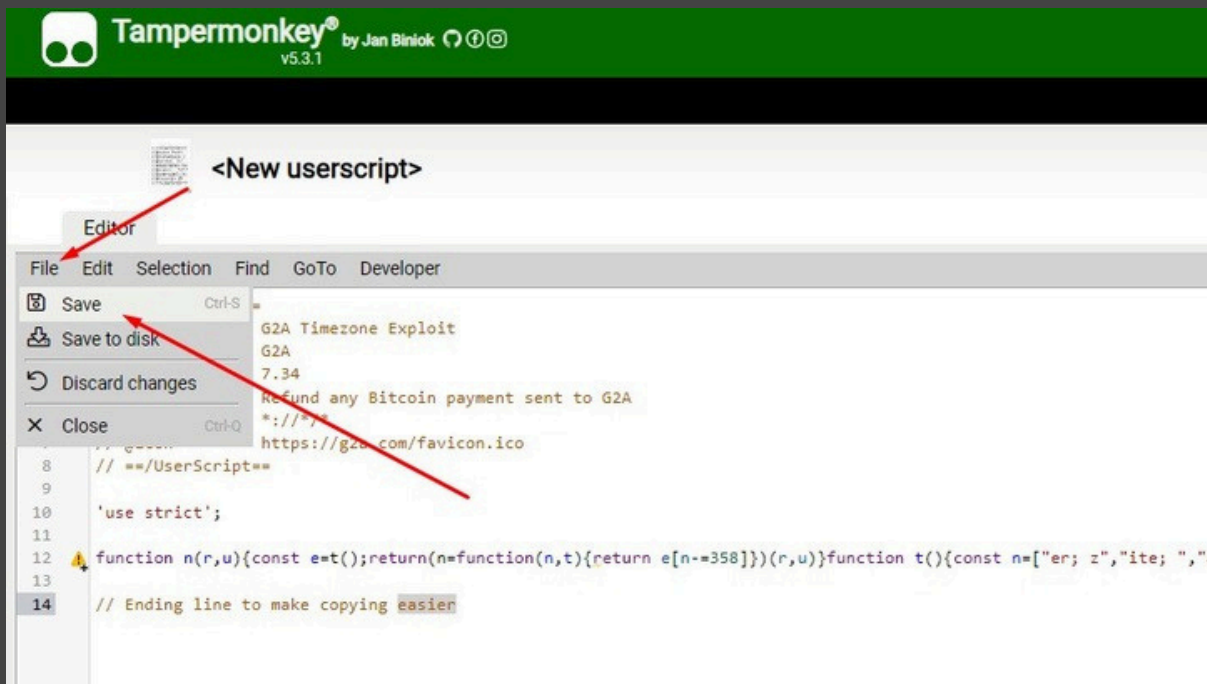

Then paste it in the editor from step 3. It should look like the screenshot below.

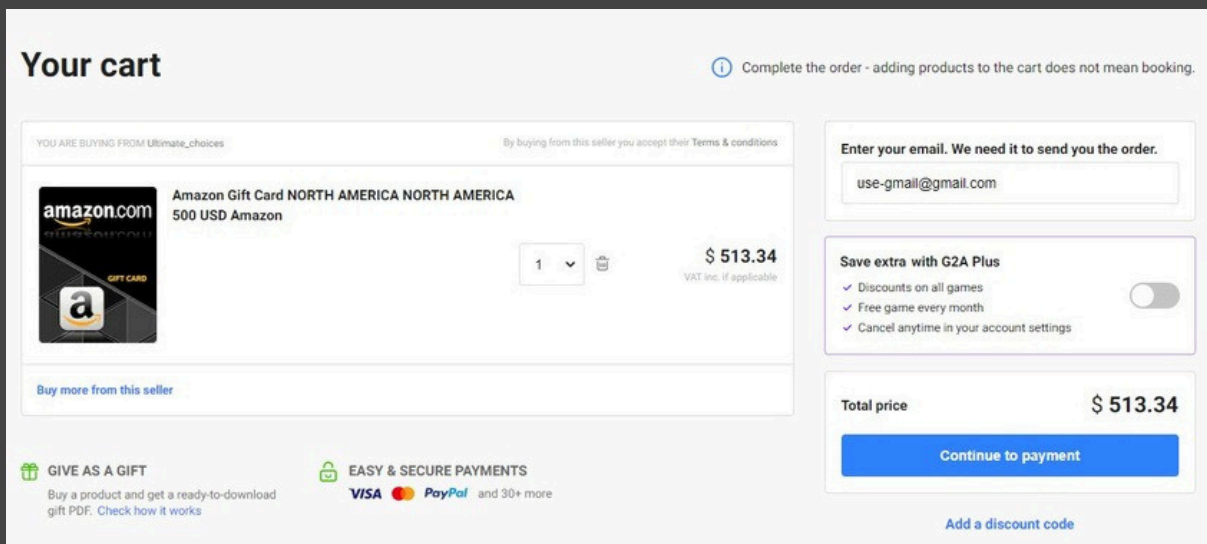


Important: The yellow triangle-shaped sign (⚠) in the code is completely normal and you should just ignore it – the script works correctly.

Step 7. Click "Save & Close".



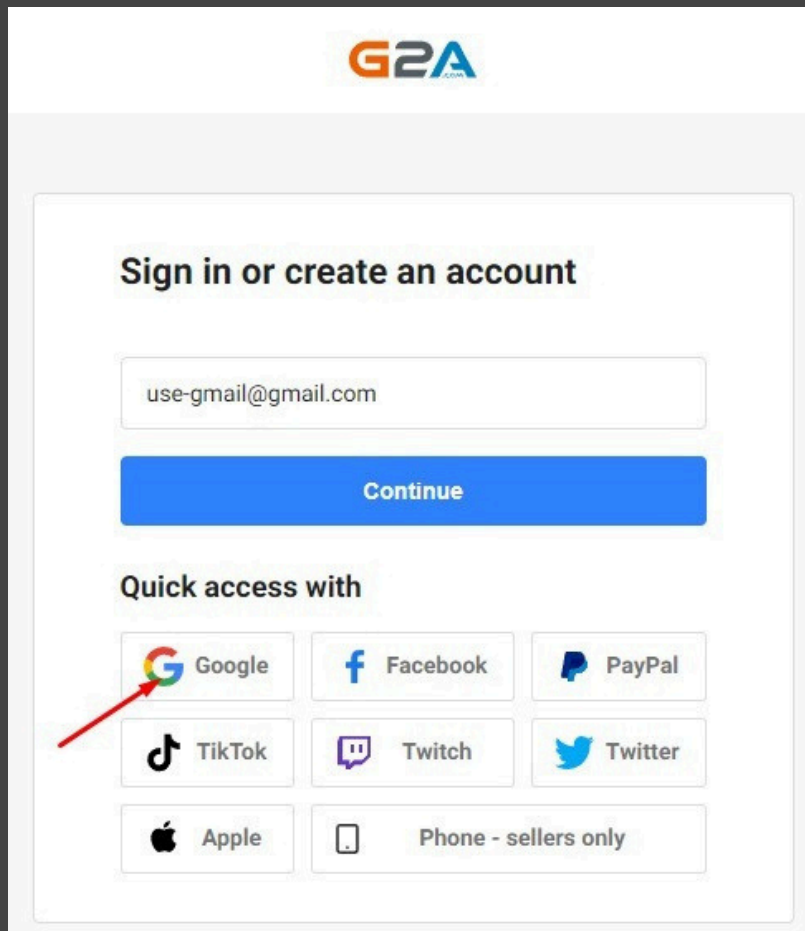
Step 8. Go to <https://www.g2a.com/> and add some products to your cart. For example, I will get a \$500 Amazon gift card.



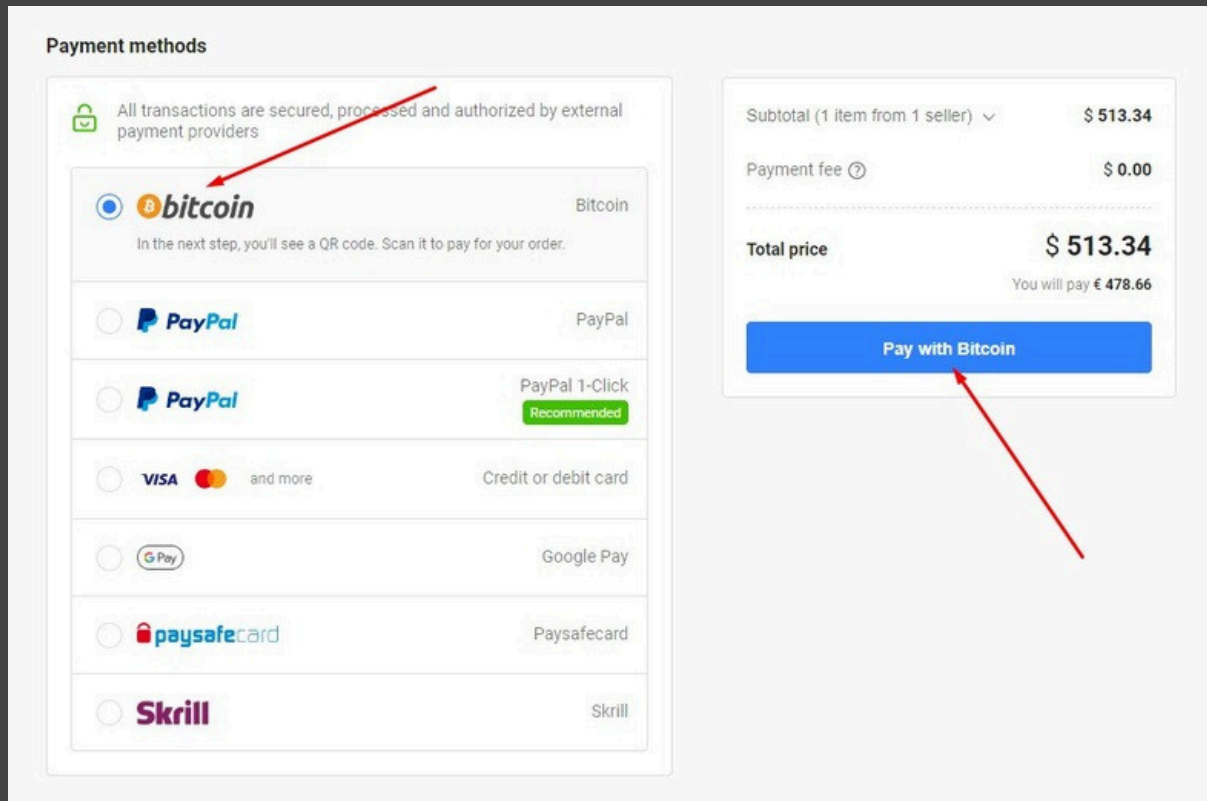
Enter your email address, and click "Continue to payment".

Important: Use popular email providers like gmail, yahoo etc., other emails like temporary emails could be blacklisted by g2a and you can experience some errors that won't let you place an order.


Step 9. If G2A asks you to create an account before placing an order, simply select "Continue with Google" and sign in with your Google account. This is the easiest and fastest method. When I attempted to register an account using a temporary email, I encountered an "expired link" error and couldn't complete the process.



Step 10. Now choose Bitcoin. Sometimes the "Bitcoin" option is not visible. In that case, just click on "Show more methods" at the bottom of the list, and you should see this payment option as well. Then click "Pay with Bitbay" or "Pay with Bitcoin".




Step 11. Now simply pay for the products by sending Bitcoins to the address displayed in your order.

Once you pay for the order, just wait for 1 confirmation in the blockchain. As soon as your transaction gets 1 confirmation in the blockchain (it shouldn't take longer than 15 minutes), **you will receive an email from G2A with your purchased products.**







Step 12. Now click "Confirm payment" and you will see this message:

 **Session expired!**

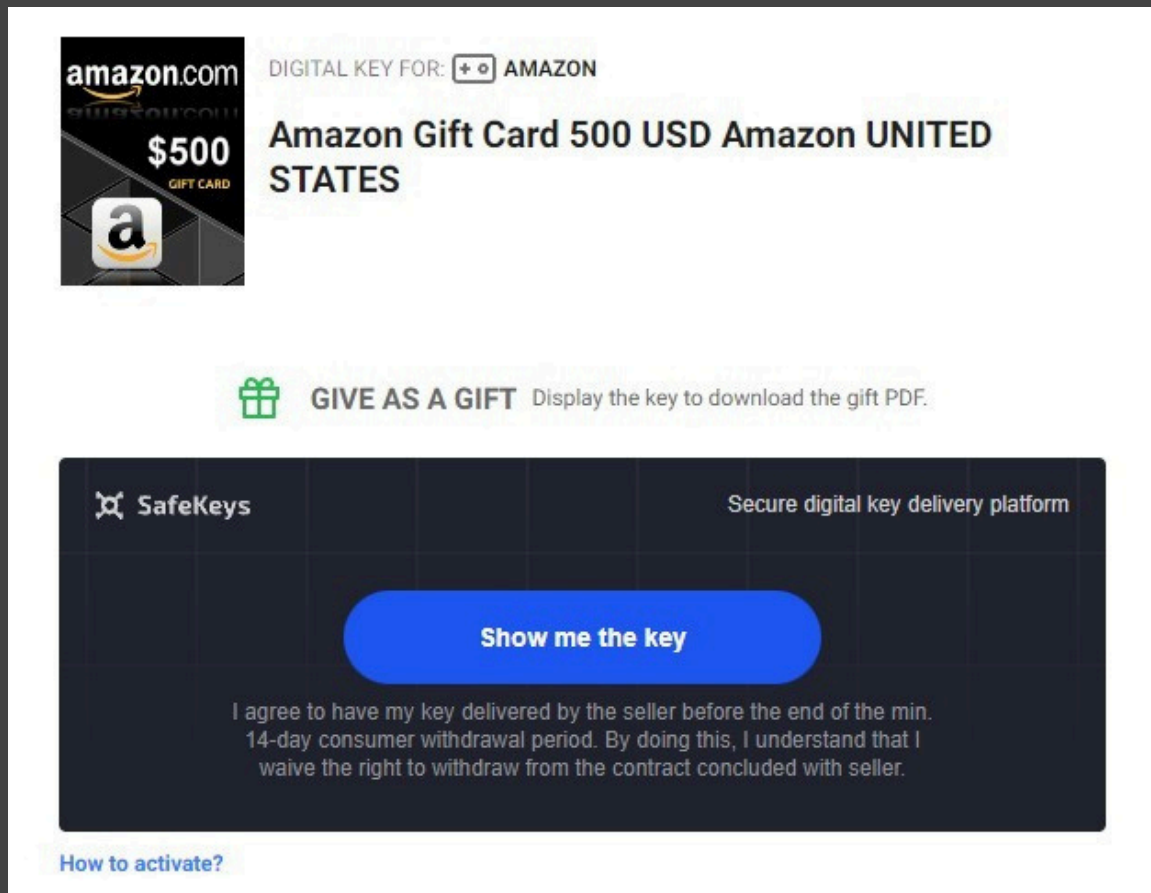
Your session has expired. If you completed any payment, it will be refunded to your wallet within a few minutes. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused.

Total price **\$ 513.34**

It usually takes from 1 to 15 minutes to get your money refunded by Bitbay. I sent the payment at 11:50 AM and was refunded 13 minutes later (it only depends on how quickly your payment gets confirmed in the blockchain).

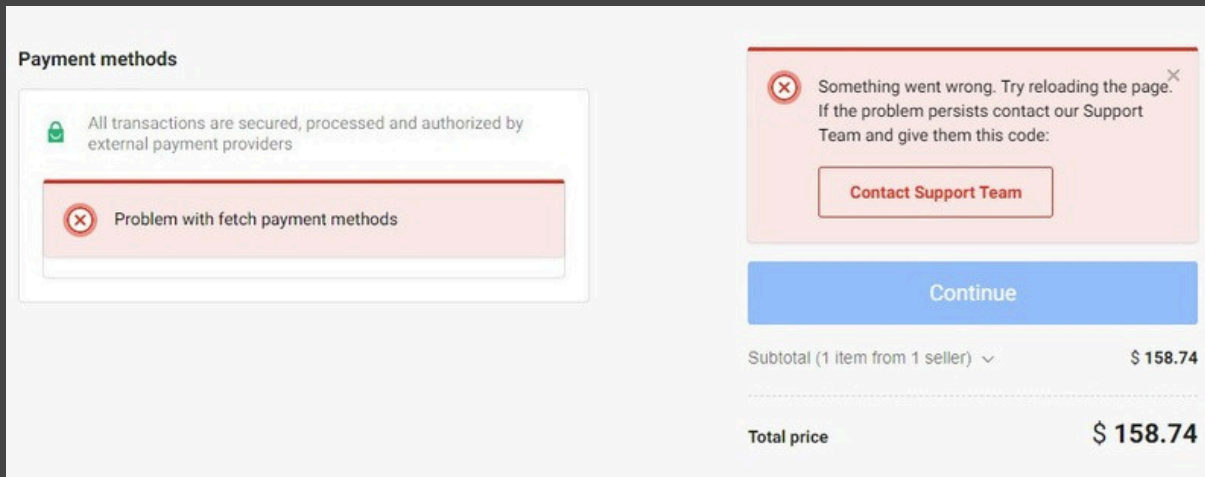
And... this is what I received in my email:



And that is literally a free \$500 gift card since my payment was refunded, but the product was sent to my email anyway.

On the next page, you can find **possible errors** that may occur while using this method and **possible solutions** that could help you fix them.

Possible Errors:

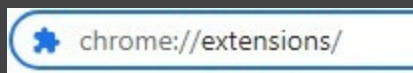


If you **can't see payment methods**, or if you can't **"Continue"** to see the **Bitcoin address**, amount, and you see the "Something went wrong" message or anything similar, it means that either your IP/email/session/browser fingerprint has been banned. In that case, you should first try:

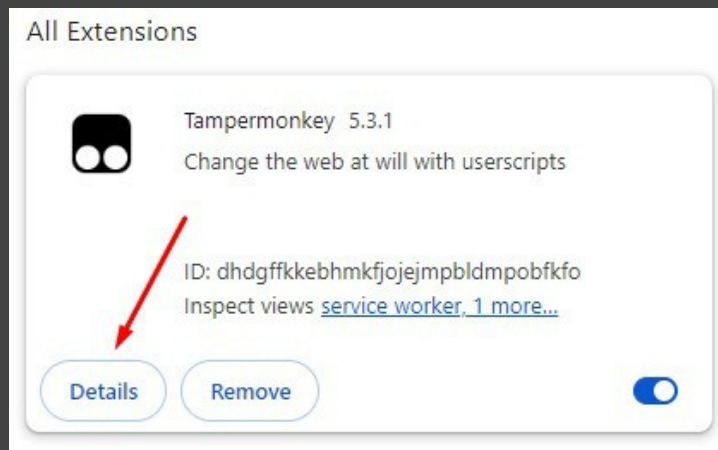
- 1) Clearing your cookies and try again,if error persists, try:
- 2) Clearing cookies again and using a different email on checkout this time. If the error persists, try:
- 3) Changing your IP address (try using a VPN)+ take actions from Step 2 again.
- 4) **If you still get this error,then change your IP again,use a different email (USE GMAIL OR OTHER POPULAR PROVIDERS) but this time use "Incognito mode" in Chrome.**

To do this, follow these steps:

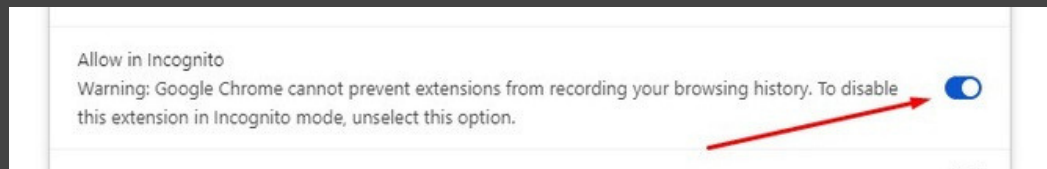
1. Go to <chrome://extensions/> (paste this in the address bar and press Enter)



2. Go to "Details" of the Tampermonkey extension



3. Allow it to be used in "Incognito mode"



4. Open "Incognito mode"

5. Repeat all the steps from the guide (including adding the script again). Also, remember that whenever you close the incognito tab, the script will be removed and you will have to add it again.
