If this layout leaves cuts smaller than 1/2 tile, adjust individually prior to installation for visible defects. Measure the width of the room and divide by the width of the tile. Begin by finding the center point of the wall, using a level to draw a plumb line in the wall's center.

Apply mortar to both the surface of the substrate and the back of the tile. If the remainder is 1/8 inch or less, cut down the width of the first row to allow. Lay out a row of loose tiles across the bottom of the wall from the center line leaving uniform joints between tiles. Installing ceramic tile, porcelain tile or even natural stone, might be a project you want to do yourself. Lay the back parallel to the short side of the panel. Start at a corner and work left to right. Panoramic Porcelain Surfaces at the same time. This collection is comprised of stone-looks that construct unique visuals.
