In my Chrome browser I have two options which are mutually exclusive: "Download PDF' s" and "Open PDF's in Chrome" The problem is that instead of automatically opening the PDF, IE displays a download prompt even though it knows what kind of file it is. However, downloading a PDF is still possible. Click the slide to the right of "Always download PDF files" and slide it to turn it blue. To get started launch Edge and click the Settings and More (three dots) button in the upper right-hand corner and click on Settings.
