the hanen more pdf than words program is a 12- week program that will be offered via telehealth on tuesdays from 9- 11am march 1 – may 17. joint attention (hanen) joint attention happens when two people pay attention to the same thing and let each other know that they are sharing that moment. pillows: place them around the floor like stepping stones and help your child ‘ jump’ from pillow to pillow. they do this by looking at each other, gesturing (pointing to it), and/ or saying something about the thing they are paying attention to. learning that words are made up of sounds is an important skill in learning to read.
