

Therefore it is imperative that the person who sends a document requiring two signatures must provide two signature fields created for the form to be signed by the signatories. Don't let bugs or incorrect security settings prevent you from digitally signing PDFs. Under Category, click Digital Signatures, and then click Enable digital signatures for specific data in the form. First, before you secure your PDF you need to add unsigned signature field (one or more) at the places in the document where you want the signatures to appear. To sign a PDF document or form, you can type, draw, or insert an image of your handwritten signature. This can be done in Adobe Acrobat.
