PDF customisation only applies to space exports (not single page exports via tools > export to pdf). Confluence's PDF customisations use a combination of HTML and CSS (Cascading Style Sheets). Use the noprint macro to mark some text on a Confluence page. For the workaround, export a single page: edit your stylesheet; go to: space tools; content tools; export; select. PDF export methods. Click the 'edit' button and the 'PDF export stylesheet' section expands to an editable text box. Here are some examples of common CSS overrides that you can use in your PDF stylesheet.
