Here is how to set Adobe as the default PDF viewer: Control-click a PDF on your computer. If the PDF opens, the site you were viewing could have a problem For example, to change the behavior for Reader, create a DWORD at this location: HKCU\SOFTWARE\Adobe\Acrobat Reader\\AVGeneral\bValidateBytesBeforeHeader=dword Always change the product and version number in the preference path to match your installation. While trying to open a PDF on Adobe Acrobat, you can encounter two types of issues, which we'll discuss below. 1 The Software Cannot Be Opened. Scan to see if the PDF has malware, since Adobe Acrobat could be protecting you by not opening the PDF. Under Advanced Properties, ensure that you are running Adobe as an administrator StepOpen Windows Settings (Win+I) and navigate to Apps. Go to Control Panel or Settings then Control Panel. On the menu, click Get Info. StepClick the three-dot menu and select Modify to launch the Adobe Acrobat repair module. Locate a PDF on your computer, select it, and then click Open. Tap Change All to apply this change to all future PDF documents. (Windows only) From the Files Of Type menu, choose All Files. So, if you're struggling to open a PDF on your laptop, try these tips to resolve the problem: Install a reliable PDF reader. Either the program doesn't even open or crashes right after opening Right-click on the thumbnail of any PDF file. Windows: Press Control+O. Navigate to the "Open With:" section and select Adobe Acrobat DC or Reader from the dropdown list. Restart Acrobat after closing all programs running in the background. This method allows the PDF to display on machines you control How to change default PDF viewer on a Mac from Preview to Adobe. Click on Acrobat or Adobe ReaderAgain open run command Win+R> type %temp% > delete all the files there Mac OS: Choose File > Open (or Open File). The first problem is that the software doesn't open when you click the icon. StepClick the Next button, select Click the Start button at the bottom-left of your screen.
