TAKING THE TORAH SCROLL FROM THE ARK Reader: inv 'FIN '9 Congregation and Reader The Minhah (sometimes spelled Mincha) Service on Saturday Shabbat afternoon contains a number of significant additions to the regular weekday Afternoon Service. It is composed of the recitation of Psalm, the Amidah, a prayer of repentance and the concluding prayer to all Jewish prayer services, Aleynu. Maariv, the evening Minchah moves from passages related to the daily afternoon service in the Holy Temple into Ashrei (Psalm), building up to the nineteen-blessing amidah (silent prayer) .
