APA style is one of the most common formats for citing sources. Other well-known citation styles include MLA and Chicago. APA Style citations consist of two parts: In-text citation: A brief citation in parentheses when you mention a source, citing the author's last name and the year of publication, e.g. (Smith, 2018). It identifies the full source in the reference list. This guide contains examples of common types of APA Style references. The American Psychological Association (APA) style provides a foundation for effective scholarly communication because it helps authors present their ideas in a clear, concise, and consistent manner.
