Use the tools in the Inspector window to view more information about the PDF or image. Open the image or document in the Preview app. Reboot normally and test again. To choose how to display documents, click PDF or Images, then choose an option next to "Define % scale as.". To display a PDF or image at the same dimensions regardless of the screen's resolution: Select "Size on screen equals size on printout." With Preview selected, head to the OS X Menu Bar and select View > Thumbnails. You can also switch to Thumbnail view by using the keyboard shortcut Option-Command You'll see a sidebar slide Click the File button in the Menu Bar. In the export window that appears, adjust the file name and format as needed. This will open another instance of the document without opening another instance of the Preview application, so you can switch between the two documents using ⌘ ` as normal. Click the Microsoft Hit ⌘ P or choose File > Print and when the print dialog comes up, instead of printing choose Open PDF in Preview from the PDF menu.
