to type directly with the computer keyboard: type a consonant to get ■ (by default) type e for ä and ee (or é) for ■. direction: left to right. each character in the amharic script represents a specific sound, and these sounds combine to form syllables and words. these basic letters make up the consonants in the language – they' re the original form of the letter before the vowels are added. need to type ethiopic letters outside of amharic, you can do so with the “ unicode keyboard”. in amharic script, there are about 317 different alphabets including 238 core characters, 50 labialized characters, 9 punctuation marks, and 20 numerals which are written and read, as in english.
