Full details of references used are then included in a reference list. Graphs, Charts, Maps, Statistics etc. More information on references and reference examples are in Chapters 1 and 2 of the Publication Manual as well as the Concise Guide to APA. Luckily, most PDFs you will want to use for school assignments and/or papers will clearly show the main information you need for any citation: Author, Date, Title, and Publication Information. This format is used to indicate the source of the idea or information you are using (when you learn how to reference using the APA referencing style, Title of document, GENERAL, search for the source themselves if they wish to pursue that idea further. When using APA format, follow the author-date method of in-text citation. A is an in-text referencing style. Journal Articles, Books & eBooks, Resources, Other Sources, APA BASICS, APA Referencing Guide PDF, Download (PDF, KB). Referencing allows your readers to understand where your argument or opinion fits into the broader academic discussion. This means that the author's last name and the year of publication for the source should appear in the text, like, for example, (Jones, 2018). See that you are writing from an informed position with evidence and support for your claims. A is an in-text referencing style. Every work cited is titled "References". Similarly, referencing a graph or figure in your work requires attribution. Information from outside sources, URL or DOI.
